I am attaching horeto two plans, one showing and the other the additional shore frontage to the west of white Bear Lake, which the Town has recently made application to lease subject to certain stated terms and conditions.

You are source of the offer which has been made by the foun of Carlyle in connection with both these properties, which effer is clearly set forth in the estached copy of a letter dated August 26th last, from Manage. Corden & Gorden, Darristers, Regime, to the Deputy Minister of Justice, Ottown.

Tou will make that with respect to that portion of the Receive at present occupied by the Town of Carlyle the Offer is unde to pay 9500.00 in each and an annual rental of \$400.00 until the year 1938, after which this annual rental will be supplemented by an additional sum of ten per cent of the gross rentals reserved by the Town of Carlyle from the property held under lease.

Town has made application to lease, you will note the an offer of \$400.00 rental per assume is made under that identical acaditions and including a participation in the green rentals subsequent to 1938.
