officer or fergeant, being in the execution of his office, shall suffer punishment according to the nature of such offence, by the sentence of the board of field officers, not exceeding however a fine of forty shillings and fifteen days imprisonment.

ARTICLE VI.

Sergeants exempted to ferve on juries, &c.

Be it also enacted, That the sergeants of the towns, suburbs and precincts, shall not be compelled to serve in the offices of jurors or constables as long as they continue to be fergeants.

ARTICLE VII.

The governor cipliniug the militia.

Provifo.

Be it also enacted by the same authority, That it shall be lawful for the governor or commander in chief for the time being, to make from time to may make regu-lations for dif- time, and issue under his hand and seal, such regulations as he shall think necessary for the better discipline of the militia. Provided nevertheless, that the offenders against such regulations shall not be liable to a higher fine than that of forty shillings, and to an imprisonment of more than eight days.
