nation thall he desired, and that it be still insisted on, on the Captors part, that the said Capture is Lawful Prize, and that the contrary be still persised in, on the Claimants behalf, That then the said Judge or Judges thall softhwith cause such Capture to be Apprized by Persons named on the part of the Captor, and sworn truly to Appraise the same according to the best of their Skill and Know-ledge, and shall after such Appraisement made, and within the space of Fourteen Days after the making of such Claim, preced to take good and sufficient Security from the Claimants, to pay to the Captors the full value thereof, according to such Appraisement, in case the same shall be adjuged Lawful Prize, and after such Security duly given, the said Judge or Judges shall make an Intersocutory Order sor Releasing, or Delivering the same to such Claimant or Claimants, or his or their Agents; and the same shall be adually Released or Delivered accordingly.

And it is further Enaded by the Authority aforefaid, That if any Claimant or Claimants hall refuse to give such Security, the Lidge or Judges hall cause the Captor or Captors in like manner to give good and sufficient Security, to be approved of by the Claimant or Claimants, to pay to the said Claimant or Claimants the full value according to the Appraisement, in take any such Capture or Captures thall be Adjudged not to be Lawful Prize; and the said Judge or Judges thall thereupon proceed to make an Interlocutory Order for the Releasing and Delivering of the same to the said Captor or

Captozs, or their Agents.

And it is further Enaced by the Authority aforesaid, That all fuch Captors, as aforelate, which thall be trought into any of Her Bajesties Colonies of Plantations in America, shall, without breaking Bulk, stay there, and be under the joint Care and Cusady of the Maval Officer of the Port or Place whereto the same chall be brought, and of the Captors thereof, and their Agents, until either the same hall by knal Sentence have been Cleared and Discharged. or Adjudged and Condenued as Lawful Prize, or that such Interlocutory Orders, as aforesaid, thall have been made sor the Reseafing of Delibering of the same ; and upon the Condemnation of Adjudication thereof as Lawful Prize, mall (in case the same were taken by any luch Picoateer Ship of Ships, as aforelaid) be immediately Delivered unto the Captors thereof, and their Agents, to be by them disposed as their Goods and Chattels, and (in Case the same were taken by any of Her Hajesties Ships of War) unto furh Person or Persons, and to be so Divided and Disposed, as her Pajelly, her heirs of Successors hall in that behalf direct; and that if any Judge or Judges, or other Officer or Officers to whom respectively it thall Appertain, shalf Delay the Doing, Performing, Daking of Pronouncing any of the leveral Proceedings, Patters or Things for, towards or relating to the Conceming of Discharging, Releasing of Delivering of any fuch Capture in manner afozelato, within the respective times herein befoge Limited, or as foon as the same or any of them ought to be cone, (according to the Tenoz and True meaning of this Ax) all and every fuch entine.
