

Terms of the Courts
of Appeal.

LXIV. And be it further enacted by the authority aforesaid, that the Judges of the said Court of Appeal shall hold their sittings in the City of Quebec, for appeals from Judgements, in causes from the District of Quebec, from the fifth to the twentieth day of February, and from the fifth to the twentieth day of July in each year, and in the City of Montreal for appeals from Judgements in causes from the District of Montreal, from the fifth to the twentieth day of June, and from the fifth to the twentieth day of December in every year.

Who are to preside at
the said Courts of Appeal.

LXV. And be it further enacted by the authority aforesaid, that the Chief Justice of the Province, or in his absence the Chief Justice of the Court of King's Bench for the District of Montreal, or in the absence of either of the said Chief Justices, the Senior Judge of those who are hereby declared Judges of the Court of Appeal, shall preside in the said Court.

Appeals from Three
Rivers to be heard at
Quebec.

LXVI. And be it further enacted by the authority aforesaid, that nothing herein contained shall extend or be construed to extend, to cause appeals from causes determined in the District of Three-Rivers from being brought elsewhere than before the Court of Appeal in the Terms thereof, to be holden at Quebec.
