That this House will not grant leave of ^{Leave of absence.} absence to any Member (unless that there are forty-three Members present in town), but on the most urgent and accidental business specially stated to the House.

LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL.

22.

That the Master in Chancery attending ^{Messenger of the Legislative Council.} the Legislative Council, be received, as their Messenger, at the Clerk's Table, the Members sitting; where he shall deliver such Message as he is charged with from the Legislative Council.

23.

That all Messages from this House to the ^{Messages to the Legislative Council.} Honorable the Legislative Council, be sent by one Member of this House. (*But see Standing Order XXVIII.*)

24.

That when the House shall judge it ^{Conferences with the Legislative Council.} necessary to request a Conference with the
