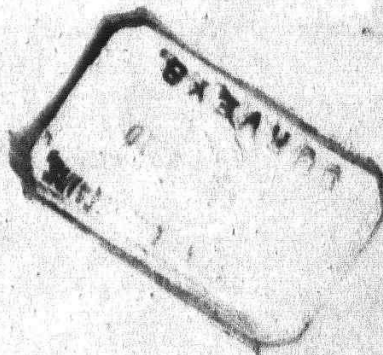
I presume the enclosed description which has been prepared as a result of a survey by a competent surveyor will be satisfactory.
