In reply to your letter of the 11th instant, with enclosures, I beg to say that some time ago Windblew Clipps with his wife and son, Thomas Windblew Clipps made application to be placed on the pay-list of the Chippewa Band of Walpole Island, and recognized as members of that band. The privilege was accorded to the two elder persons, but owing to the character which the son is stated to bear ~~the~~ he was not accepted into the band. The Indian Agent was advised to this effect. The Department has now written Thomas Windblew Clipps advising him that the decision arrived at in the matter settled the case.
