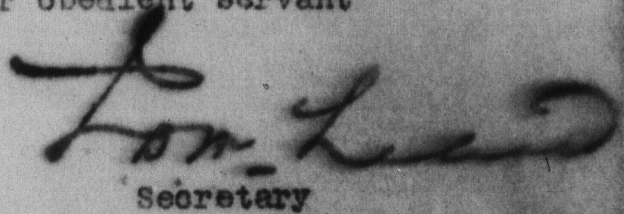
Sir:-

I shall feel obliged if you will have the investigation made to which you refer regarding the bridge which was destroyed and the matter closed with the least possible delay.

In this connection, I have to inform you that the Hon. Mr. Laird has been asked to have a valuation made of land in the said Reserve taken by your company for a borrow-pit. I shall be glad to hear from you regarding this matter.
