Sir,-

I am in receipt of your letter of the 10th instant with which you forwarded voucher No. 26 for \$72.50 in favor of St. Mary's Hospital for nursing Bert Delan, an Indian ^{child} of the Senishaw Indian Reserve, who died in the said institution; and in reply I return the voucher in question herewith, as there is an error apparently with regard to the number of days' attendance, etc., charged for. The voucher shows that the patient entered the institution on the 9th April and was there up to the 26th of that month. If this was the length of the sojourn 13 days, not 18 days, should have been charged for. The necessary changes should be made in the voucher as not only board for the patient but also for the patient's mother has been charged for 18 days. Kindly give Bert Delan's age when returning the voucher. The voucher should be certified.
