2. With regard to the delay in forwarding this application, the Officer Commanding, No. 6 District Depot, reports as follows:

" Private Day, G. R., was apprehended at Springhill, N. S., at 2115 hrs., 13th March, 1944, and escort was despatched on the 16th March, 1944, and he was placed in the No. 6 D.D. Guardroom on the 17th March, 1944. Documents were requested on the 20th March, 1944. He was remanded for summary on the 21st March, 1944, and was remanded for D.C.M. on the 22nd March, 1944, and the application was forwarded to D.H.Q. that same day."

3. This soldier will serve his sentence in No. 6 District Depot Detention Barracks until there is a vacancy in a proper Detention Barracks.
