This letter constitutes a Flight Permit issued under Section 211 (5) of the Air Regulations for **Sikorsky S-58 ET** aircraft **CFEDV** subject to the following:

- a) valid for **three (3)** test flight for purpose of Certificate of Airworthiness or Flight Permit renewal within Canada only;
- b) flight to be conducted in conditions of Day Visual Flight Rules;
- c) flight crew members, as defined by Section 101 (32) of the Air Regulations, only may be carried;
- d) a certification by a licensed Aircraft Maintenance Engineer attesting the aircraft as "serviceable" as defined in Section 101 (57B) of the Air Regulations must be entered in the Aircraft Journey Log Book prior to commencement of the flight;
- e) a certificate signed by the Pilot-in-command acknowledging invalidity of the Certificate of Airworthiness but accepting the aircraft as serviceable for flight for the test flight in accordance with Section 217 of the Air Regulations, and that he is fully acquainted with the provisions of this Flight Permit;
- f) this Permit is valid to June 17th 1973.

This Permit is conditional upon full compliance with the Air Regulations and Orders issued pursuant thereto, and may be cancelled at any time by notice in writing.
