

constitution for all grand, subordinate and juvenile lodges under its jurisdiction.

(7) To provide a revenue for Supreme Lodge by means of a representative or capitation tax upon grand, subordinate and juvenile lodges, dues and levies upon members and charges for supplies.

(8) To provide for returns from each grand lodge and from each subordinate and juvenile lodge under its immediate jurisdiction;

(9) To hear and determine all appeals from grand, subordinate and juvenile lodges, when the same are properly brought before it in accordance with the regulations of the Society, and provide legislation for the enforcement of its decisions;

(10) To enact laws and regulations of general application, carry into effect the foregoing, exercise all other powers reserved by this constitution to the Supreme Lodge, its Supreme Executive Council or officers, and do everything necessary to enforce its legitimate authority over grand, subordinate and juvenile lodges;

(11) To suspend, dissolve, forfeit or cancel the charter of any grand lodge, and where no Grand Lodge exists, of any subordinate or juvenile lodge:—

(a) For improper conduct;
