New Story Books for Bands

THE TREASURE CHEST, 12 F. M. Stories for Primary Children

CHRISTIAN GREATHEARTS, 9 F. M. Stories for the Junior grade, and contains also 3 F. M. Exercises.

FOR HIS SAKE, 6 F. M. Stories for the Senior Intermediate grade, and 3 F. M. exercises, also 3 programmes.

All these books are founded on "Prayer and Missions", and are practically the same stories only told in a different way, fitting the different aged children.

The last story in the first two books has an Easter touch. They are 18c. each.

FOR YOUR EASTER PROGRAMMES

For Circles and Y. W. Circles.

EASTER, A MESSAGE AND A PROMISE, is an Easter reading or recitation given alternately with the verses of a hymn. Music of two hymns, 5c.

THE LIVING CHRIST, a responsive service for Circles or Y. W. Circles. 2c.

THE CHALLENGE OF THE CROSS is a beautiful Consecration exercise, suitable for young women. 15c.

EASTER CHIMES is a leaflet bearing Easter messages. 2c.

AN EASTER MESSAGE is a little Easter story telling how one life yielded because the Easter message was used for the Master. 5c.

For Bands

GO QUICKLY AND TELL is an Easter service for Easter Bands, requiring about half an hour, consisting of hymns with music, recitations, etc. 5c.

AN EASTERTIDE EVENING, a complete Easter entertainment for Junior children. 5c.

JESUS, THE LIGHT OF THE WORLD, telling how the light of the first Easter day came to Jerusalem, then spread until India and Bolivia saw the light also. It has several little recitations and a hymn in it too. This was advertised last year. 10c.

THE EASTER STORY, consists of Bible, Dialogues, Recitations. 10c.

JESUS, THE LIGHT OF THE WORLD, for 15 children. Makes a pretty exercise for the tiny tots. 1c.
