REGULATIONS

Entry may be made personally at the local land office for the District

HOMESTEAD DUTIES.

A settler who has been granted ar entry for a homestead is required by the provisions of the Dominion Lands Act and the amountents thereto, to perform the conditions connected therewith, under one of the following plans:—

connected therewith, under one of the following plans:—

(i) At least six months' residence upon and cultivation of the land in each year during the term of three

each year during the term of three years.

(2) If the father (or mother, if the father is deceased) or any persent who is eligible to make a homested who is eligible to make a homested entry of the land entered for this Act, residence and homestead, the requirements of this Act as to residence prior to other in the yellowing patent may be satisfied by such person tending with the father or mother.

(3) If a settler has obtained a patent for his homestead or a certificate for the issue of which patent countersigned in the manner prescribed by this Act, and homestead, the requirements of this Act as to residence may be satisfied by residence upon the first homestead, if the second homestead is in the vicinity of the first home stead.

stead.

(4) If the settler has his permanent residence upon farming land owned by him in the vicinity of his household, the requirements of this Act as to residence may be satisfied by residence upon the said land.

A settler who avails himself of the provisions of Clauses (2) (3) or (4) must cultivate 30 acres of his homestead, or substitute 20 head of sicek, with buildings for helf accommodation, and have headles 30 acres substantially fenced. Every homesteader who fails to comply with the requirements of the homesteader law is liable to have his entry cancelled, and the land may be again thrown open for entry.

Should be made at the end of the three years, before the Local Agent, Sub-Agent or the Homestead Inspector. Before making applications for patent the settler must give six Commissioner of Dominion Lands months notice in writing to the months notice in writing to the at Ottawa of his intention to do so.

Newly arrived immigrants will receive at the Immigration Office in Winnipeg, or at any Jominion Lands Office in Manitoba or the Morthwest Territories.
