STAGES IN THE GREAT ADVANCE

Lull in German Attack Only a Period of Preparation. PLACING THEIR GREAT GUNS Enemy Ready to Sacrifice

London, March 10.—Col. Repington, the military critic of the Times, emphasizes the necessity of recognizing the fact that the Germans on the western front are determined to secure a great decision and says that the temporary relaxation and recrudescence of attacks represent only stages in the great advance.

It is the guns that are playing the principle role now, and guns are commonly difficult to move, especially such very heavy guns and howitzers, in such weather as this, and in view of the fact that the French steadily hold the dominating positions and are quick to act on the slightest sign of a move.
