Synopsis of Canadian North-We t Land Regulations.

THE sole head of a family, or any male over 18 years old, may homestead a quarter section of available Dominion land in Manitoba, Saskatchewan or Alberta. Applicant must appear in person at the Dominion Lands Agency or sub-Agency for the district. Entry by roxy may be made at any Dominion Lards Agency (but not Sub-Agency.) on serian conditions.

Duties—Six months residence upon and rallivation of the and in each of three sears. A homesteader may live within sine miles of his-homestead on a farm of at least 80 acres, on certain conditions. A habitable house is required except where residence is performed in the vicinity. In certain districts a homesteader in good standing may pre-empt a quarter section alongside his homestead. Price \$5.00 per acre.
