GOVERNOR FRASER DEAD AT GUYSBORO

Lieutenant-Governor of Nova Scotia Succumbs After An Illness Extending Over Several Months. Was 65 Years of Age. Was Prominent In Public Life In Nova Scotia For Many Years. Known As the Giant of Guysboro, Owing To His Great Stature.

Gaysboro, N.S., Sept. 27.—Lieutenant-Governor Dr. C. Fraser died today. He had been in poor health since June and since he went for Guysboro, where he has been staying at his summer home all the summer, had been confined to his bed for some time. He was, however, in good spirits, and friends who visited him found him bright and cheerful.
