MY WORST BLUNDER

Famous "Bonehead" Plays on Major League Diamonds Explained by Leading Baseball Players to

Veteran Third Baseman Now With Boston, Who for Many Years Has Been Rated at the Head of His Class as a Player.

It shows what a little thing it takes to turn a game, to change a pennant race and upset the work of a whole season. I made a blunder once that while it isn't uncommon, I always shall think was the worst I ever made in my life.

It wasn't so much the mistake itself as the way it came up, and its effect, that makes the blunder seem so bad to me. I have made the same play, or similar plays many times and, every time, I have been right. But this time it made me, but that doesn't excuse it. I knew it was a mistake, but I couldn't help it. I don't tell this to excuse myself, as it doesn't make any difference now, but maybe it will cause the fans to go a bit easier on some young fellow if he makes the same kind of a break.

It was when I was playing third base for the New York team in 1905. We were the leaders, but the Chicago club was beginning to get strong, and at the time was pushing us hard and threatening to win out. The series meant, or seemed to mean, the decision of the pennant race, and of course both teams were fighting hard. We had a lead of one run, and in the last

of the eighth, Slagle, and I think Chance, got on bases with no one out. The play, of course, was to sacrifice, and we were all set for it. The first bunt was a foul and the next was a strike. I backed up a bit, not too far to come in, but far enough to protect myself if a sharp hit came in my direction. It was a thousand to one the batter would not try to bunt again—but he did, and I saw the ball come rolling toward me down the third base foul line I went in at top speed. I saw that it was going foul, and that the batter would be out on strikes, but I was so crazy to make a play that for the life of my I couldn't let it go. I was just on the foul line when I made a dive, grabbed it and shot to first. I got the man, but the runner moved up. I went back to my position, almost sick at the idea of making such a blunder, and I almost prayed for the next two to go out. One popped out, but the next was a hard hit to the center, drove home two runs, and beat us right there. We scored one hit in the ninth and scored it up, but in the tenth we lost it. If I had only let that ball roll a foot or two further and kept my hands off it, we would have won the game. Chicago took the series and for a time it looked as if they would overtake us and win the pennant, but we pulled ahead later and clinched it.

If we had lost that championship, I always should have blamed myself for it. It was a little thing, but you can see how such little things count.

The great trouble is too much in the head. A champion is a bad job to hold if one is ambitious to get rich quick. For what? I have seen a lot of fellows who have made a fortune in the stock market, but they have lost it all in a moment.

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PRINCE AND BURGLAR FIGHT FOR A CROWN

Daring Attempt to Steal Imperial Diadem of the Late Emperor of Brazil

Pretender to Throne Finds That Athletic Training Is of Use to Him

PARIS, Sept. 12.—Prince Louis of Orleans and Braganza last night captured a burglar who was endeavoring to steal the imperial crown of Brazil, which is religiously preserved at the historic castle of Est, near Dieppe. The prince is the grandson of Dom Pedro, the late emperor of Brazil, who was dethroned, and passed his declining years in Paris. His mother, Princess Isabelle, the emperor's only daughter, married a dashing French prince of the Orleans family, the Comte d'Eu, who is now the pretender to the throne of Brazil.

Toward eight o'clock Prince Louis was walking through the great assembly hall on the first floor of the castle with the little Irish terrier, who is his inseparable companion, when the animal suddenly rushed to a door leading to a staircase, and began to bark furiously.

Fight With Burglar. Opening the door, the prince discovered, crouching on the stairs, an individual whom he recognized as Louis Nieuftin, who had formerly been employed in the castle, but who had been dismissed for dishonesty. Nieuftin, a muscular young fellow of 28, made a rush at the prince, but the latter's athletic training enabled him to overcome the intruder quickly.

When searched, Nieuftin's overcoat was found to contain the imperial crown of Brazil, which he had been endeavoring to steal. He was taken to the police station and is now being held in custody.

In addition to this body, Nieuftin carried a full loaded revolver, and a huge dagger of highly tempered steel. On one side of the blade of the formidable weapon was an Italian inscription, "Che la Morte sia Morte" (Let death be death), and on the other the words "Corsican Vendetta" (Corsican Vendetta).

It is said that after being discharged from the castle Nieuftin had enlisted in an artillery regiment in Corsica, where he procured this dagger. For some reason that is not yet clear, Nieuftin had been discharged from his regiment at the end of six months. After leaving the island he ultimately came to Paris in June, with an amply filled trunk, and took a room at a hotel in the Montmartre district.
