Prince Ching and Li Hung Chang Attach Their Autographs.

The Joint Note Now in a Position For Discussion by the Powers—The Appointment of Chang Chih Tung—Prince Ching Does Not Want Him as a Partner in the Negotiating Business—Railway Cession Denied.

Pekin, Sunday, Jan. 13.—The joint note of the powers has finally been signed by the Chinese Peace Commissioners. Prince Ching signed yesterday, and Li Hung Chang, who is better, signed to-day.

As to Chang Chih Tung. So far as Chang Chih Tung is concerned, the foreign envoys, who know him personally, say that while he is strongly anti-foreign and has never made any secret of his likes and dislikes, they believe he would be a satisfactory representative of the Chinese, and there would not be any objection to him on the score of his recent utterances.

RUSSIA GETS NO RAILWAY. Foreign Office Says Lord Salisbury Has Not Ceded Chinese Line.

London, Jan. 14.—The Foreign Office here declares that the report of the cession of the New Chwang Shan Hai Kuan Railroad to Russia by Lord Salisbury is unfounded. It points out that Great Britain has no power to cede it, as the railroad is Chinese property.

MR. BLAIR HAS NOT CHANGED.

Stands in the Same Old Place as He Did Last Year.

He Uses the Same Arguments as When the Kettle River Valley Bill Was Up—The People of B. C. Have a Right to All the Railway Connections They Can Get—Coal Areas Practically Inexhaustible.

Montreal, Jan. 15.—Here is Hon. A. G. Blair's position on the railway question: "As a member of the Railway Committee of the House of Commons, before which such an application for a charter would have to come, it would be impossible for me to express an opinion as to what course I would pursue with respect to any particular bill until I heard all the particulars, pro and con, that would be urged for and against the application. Speaking generally, however, I stand to-day exactly where I stood when the Kettle River Valley Railway bill was under discussion. The same district was to be served by a railway south of the boundary, and I supported it both in the House and in committee. I said then, and I say now, that the people of British Columbia have a perfect right to have all the railway connections, north, south, or by any other way, that they believe necessary to the rapid and complete development of the resources of that Province.
