Eligible Activities

The following areas of study would be eligible for consideration:

- geopolitical and security issues in the Asia-Pacific region and their implications for Canadian interests;
- the consequences for Canada of political developments and economic growth and restructuring in particular Asia-Pacific countries;
- the globalization of Asian financial markets and financial flows and their ramifications for Canada's economic position;
- science, technology and development in the Asia-Pacific region and its impact on Canada's competitive position;
- the prospects for regional and sub-regional trade arrangements and other consultative mechanisms and the potential role for Canada in such developments;
- environmental challenges facing regional countries and the opportunities for pan-Pacific collaboration;
- the impact of Asia-Pacific immigration on the Canadian economy;
- issues in specific sectors such as transport, communications, agriculture, fisheries, energy or other resources that affect Canadian economic and trade issues in Asia-Pacific;
- any topic of current significance to Canadian policy options in relation to the region.
