

tories throughout the United Kingdom, and in 1951 served as President of the British Association for the Advancement of Science. He also sponsored the Commonwealth study conference on the human aspects of industrialization held at Oxford in 1956.

The Duke has made numerous visits to Canada, both accompanying The Queen and on his own account. He went to Vancouver in the summer of 1954 to open the Commonwealth Games. In October 1958, Prince Philip attended, as President, the World Conference of the English Speaking Union. In 1960 and 1962, he made further visits to Canada to plan, and to preside at, the second Study Conference on Consequences of Changing Industrial Development.

A collection of speeches made by Prince Philip covering the years 1956 to 1959 has been published under the title *Prince Philip Speaks*.
