



## WHAT'S NEXT?

The deadline for the current round of trade negotiations is January 1, 2005. There are already a number of commitments to reduce tariffs and remove barriers by that date, and more will be negotiated among WTO members.

Ministers will meet at the 5th Ministerial Conference in Cancun in September 2003 to assess the issues and to take decisions on the negotiating agenda.
