Occupational Safety and Health

"A high priority in the Public Service of Canada is providing working conditions conducive to the safety and health of employees.

The prevention of accidents and the provision of a safe and healthy work environment are recognized as matters of major importance. While managers and supervisors are ultimately accountable for the health and safety of their employees, Treasury Board policies and the Canada Labour Code, Part 11, state that it is a shared responsibility.

Employees have the right to contribute and be involved in safety and health programs. Good results can best be achieved by management, supervisors and employees working together."
