“Cape Breton,” Dredge, Loss of:

Resolution,—That approval should be given to any measure proposed by the Government to compensate the families of those who lost their lives through wreck of: Mr. Kyte; withdrawn, 291.

Capital Punishment, abolition of:

1. Resolution,—That as the Russian Government has recently abolished capital punishment, and as the people of Canada are much exercised over the question, a plebescite should be taken at the next general election: Mr. Bickerdike; negatived, 290.
2. Resolution,—That as there now lies a lad of sixteen years under condemnation of death whose father is on overseas service, the death penalty is contrary to dictates of civilization and christianity, etc.: Mr. Bickerdike; ruled out of Order, 290.
3. Resolution,—That death penalty as applied to women and children should be abolished: Mr. Bickerdike; ruled out of Order, 321.
