## MOTIONS.

For Wednesday, 23rd May, 1883.

By the Honorable Mr. *O'Donohoe* :—

1883.

1 May 21—That he will call the attention of this House to the question of immigration from *Great Britain* and *Ireland* to *Canada*, and will enquire, whether the Government intend to negotiate a loan with the Imperial Government or others, for the purpose of aiding and encouraging such immigration on a larger scale than hitherto.

Secondly: Whether the Government have any matured policy on the subject, or devised any means to bring before the people referred to, reliable knowledge of the resources and advantages of *Canada*, with a view to direct the stream of immigration to this country; and if so, what are they?—their nature and extent.

Inquiry by the Honorable Mr. *Trudel* :—

2 “ 21—Will the Government, before the end of the present Session, comply with an Order of this House, made three years ago, for the production of a Statement of persons employed in the Civil Service, classified according to Provinces, salaries, religions and nationalities?
