

just enough for their orchards and gardens for raising their roots, which exceed any in *America* both for largeness and taste ; and they have some flourishing orchards, and begin to make syder, and sugar they make from the maple-juice.

In many parts of the country there are very good masts for shipping, and oak for the building of ships. In the bay of *Fundy* there are variety of coals, sufficient to supply all *America* with fuel ; and there is very good reason to believe there are some valuable mines in the country, as there has been some copper ore found
