fift of a valt Fract of Land, divided into a Variety of distinct independent Governments: diffinct not only with regard to the Persons of their Governors, but differing in the very Forms of their Government In fome of which the royal Authority has but little Weight; and in others is but ill ascertained; in many of which there are internal Jealousies, the severel Parts that et apose their Legislature being at Variance amongst themselves, and in most a Jealoufy of their neighbouring Colonies, which makes them frequently regard each other's Prosperity with an evil Eve gradd to this, all those unhappy religious Differences which in the Beginning of the last Century distracted the Mother-Country, Still Sublists in that Part of the World, not only simply as Sects, but in a manner moulded into their feveral Governments, and influencing them not a little. These are Impediments which cannot be immediately and all at once removed, or their ill Effects remedied; and it is ridiculous in the highest Degree to charge that as a Crime on the Ministry, which arose from the natural Circumstances of the Country itself.
