# THE ST. PATRICK'S LITERARY INSTITUTE.

### SECTION I.-BY-LAWS.

### Be it enacted by the St. Patrick's Literary Institute of the City of Quebec, as follows, Viz :--

ARTICLE I.—The Institute shall consist of four classes of members, namely: Annual, Life, Corresponding and Honorary.

II. Annual Members shall consist of those who shall sign the Constitution and By-Laws, and pay the sum of two dollars per annum; they shall be entitled to all the privileges of the Association. Also, a class to be called Junior Members, who shall pay one dollar per annum; they shall be entitled to the privileges of the Reading Room and Library. Persons over twenty-one years of age shall not be admitted to this class.

III. Life Members shall consist of contributors of twenty dollars, and they shall be entitled to all the privileges of the Association.

No person shall be considered a member of either of these classes until he has signed personally, or by his authorized agent, the Constitution and By-laws in a book to be kept for that purpose; and he shall not be entitled to vote, nor be eligible to office, until six months of his membership shall have expired; but this restriction shall only apply to members who shall be admitted after the adoption of said By-laws.

IV. Corresponding Members shall be chosen from non-residents of the City who are favorable to the cause for which the Association has been instituted; they shall be entitled to all the privileges of the Association, except the right of voting. Before they shall be elected notice shall be given, in writing, at a regular meeting, at least one month in advance.
