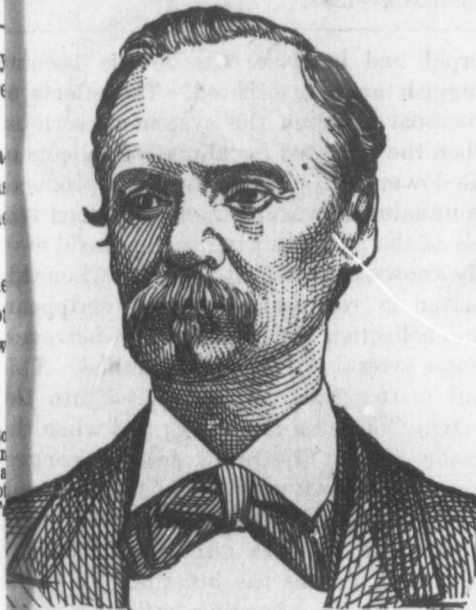

Mr. Sharon was one of the many men who have been brought into prominence through the rich mineral treasures of the West. He may be styled a silver king, having reaped a vast harvest of riches through his large interests in silver mining. While in the United States Senate, representing the State of Nevada, he used all his influence to procure the passage of the Silver bill, and finally succeeded. Few men were personally better known in Washington. He possessed many personal traits which won for him a large circle of friends and admirers. Mr. Sharon was about fifty-five years of age, and died leaving an estate said to be worth \$25,000,000.
