IT'S ALL IN THE MAYOR'S HANDS.

Both the Grand Trunk and the C.P.R. Would Like to Carry Sunlight Soap.

Now for the deluge. A sub-committee of the Property Committee touched the button yesterday, which should charge all the wires at City Hall and set the Coxey army pulling them. It will now be in order for them to lay siege to the Mayor.

Fifteen Jobs to be Given Out. The sub-committee meeting in the Law Library room at the new City Hall yesterday afternoon decided that some fifteen jobs, varying in rank from shoe-maker to clerk, should be given out.

What Officers Must be Filled. Chairman Dunn, Ald. Sheppard, Frank and Steiner and Architect Lennox formed the committee, which has passed instructions, selected as follows:

- 1. First Engineer, must have passed electrical and stationary engineer examinations before the qualified boards.
2. Deputy Engineer, must have same qualifications.
3. Three firemen, must have experience.
4. Assistant fireman, to wheel coal.
5. Patrolman. His duty is to be general handy man about the building; to usher and give information to visitors. He is to report to the City Commissioner.
6. Resident caretaker and helps Mr. Lennox's bill will require at least 2000 a year, would involve salary out of 4000 a year. The caretaker would be given a lump salary, out of which he should employ help and supply materials for cleaning. The Architect, if he had his trial, would not allow anything for it.
7. Three elevator-men. Must have testimonials as to ability, and be of good moral character. Outside man, gardener or caretaker of grounds.
8. Two boys to attend to lavatories and shine shoes; small salary and tips.
9. A page-boy. Must be able to wait upon customers when in Council or at committees.
10. The matter of appointing a telephone girl was not agreed upon until Manager Dunlop of the Bell Telephone Company has first been seen with reference to the best service to install in the building.
11. The Board of Public Works.
12. One difficulty in the way of the establishment of the Sunlight Soap Company in this city is probably removed. It is stated by the Board of Public Works that the option will leave the rest with the city.
13. The city is moving. Mr. Tarle and Mr. Mulock have been asked to do such share of the dredging asked for by Mr. Lever as devolves fairly upon the Government.
14. But the company is said to be negotiating for an option on another site. This other site is no other than the Queen's Wharf leasehold, held by the C.P.R. The negotiations have not yet matured, but it is said to be by no means impossible that they may come to terms with the C.P.R. In fact it seems to be a race, promoted between the G.T.R. and the C.P.R., for which will carry most Sunlight Soap.

The Latest Batch. There is a remote possibility that this may have something to do with solving the chin-ferry mix-up. Like everything else of importance touched by the Board of Control, the scheme of free island connection has been hooed. If at the Council meeting the controllers showed a peculiar grasp of the situation, yesterday's developments showed them to know little less. Ald. Burns confessed that he actually had known Mr. O'Connor, former letter of the Council, who apparently did not know the complete details of the company's operations. Mr. O'Connor, he said, was in charge of the ferry. He had been with Captain Hall, light-house keeper at the Queen's Wharf, to learn that the rights of the C.P.R. were the point raised by Ald. Spence and Sheppard that the city had the right-of-way of the ferry. The Mayor was adjacent to and not upon the C.P.R. leasehold, has set them thinking. The Mayor was prepared to give up 1500 a year.
