THE CORPSE TO BE RESURRECTED.

The Liberal camp will be stirred to day by an article which appears in the personal organ of Solicitor-General Fitzpatrick.

The Catholic Register of this city publishes in full the Pastoral Letter from His Grace the Archbishop of St. Boniface on the Manitoba school question and calls attention to the document in its latest editorial. Mr. Fitzpatrick's organ starts out by saying:

"We some of our faint-hearted contemporaries it seems like a sound of renewed battle. They grow pale, and in a hush of fear they warn the reader that that question is dead—it is on the other side of the grave of political possibility."

In its next sentence the organ of the Solicitor-General says:

"We should like to know by whom and when it was settled. There are two ways of settling a dispute: one, in which the parties to the dispute, in the face of the demands of right, equity and conscience are listened to and respected."
