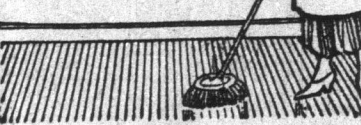

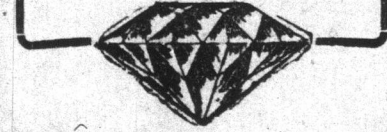

TO CONTINUE CITY FISH STALL UNLESS STOPPED BY GOVT.

Mayor Says Municipal Controlled Sales Not Yet Interfered With.

An article appearing in yesterday's
press to the effect that the Govern-
ment had recommended that municipa-
lies allow city dealers to distribute fish
under their supervision, caused jubila-
tion among local dealers, who inter-
preted the dispatch as prohibiting mun-
icipalities from going into the fish
business.

Contrary to reports, no action against
the city for attempting "to put the
dealers' out of business has been con-
templated. Although the city fish was
disposed of with great rapidity, fish
merchants stated today that some com-
plaint was registered owing to the sit-
uation of the municipal stall and the
general uncleanliness connected with
the distribution of fish.

Mayor Stevenson stated that he had
received the assurance of the Govern-
ment that no interference would be
exercised by municipal fish shops. The
city, he said, would continue selling all
fish shipped to the city by the Govern-
ment until word to the contrary is
received.

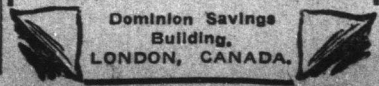
CAPACITY CROWD AT THE WINTER GARDEN

CONTRIBUTIONS TO BRITISH RED CROSS HAVE COMMENCED

Sir George Gibbons Announces That Response Is Generous.

"WE MUST NOT FAIL, MEN"

Ten Teams Assured for Thursday's Canvass-Committee's Enthusiastic Meeting.

"The citizens of London, in spite of
all the calls upon them, are again loy-
ally responding to the appeal for the
British Red Cross," said Sir George
Gibbons, chairman of the central com-
mittee, at yesterday's meeting to con-
sider plans for next Thursday's can-
vass. Sir George stated that he had
sent out a letter to a limited number
of citizens, who he expected, would
contribute generously, and so far his
response had been very good. He had
met a renewal of the kindness of Lon-
don citizens, and he was confident
that the city would not cheapen itself
at this juncture, for it would be intol-
erant that at this time of crisis the
people of Canada should fail the men
in the trenches in need of every as-
sistance of the Red Cross.

Large Attendance.
The meeting was held in the grill-
room of the Tecumseh House, and
was attended by almost every member
of the committee. Team captains re-
ported on the progress they had made,
and in ten cases there was assurance
that the teams would be complete. It
was decided to appoint the same com-
mittee of men who had acted in the
fund-raising campaign, in co-operation
with the ladies, Col. Smith, and Messrs.
McLean, George S. Gibbons, C. Hunt,
George Gunn and Magistrate
Graydon. Rev. Dr. Waller reported that
the appeal would have the support of
the city clergy, who have promised to
make announcements tomorrow.

Will Be Divided.
A. E. Silverwood, chairman of the
canvass committee, outlined the plan
that had been devised by Gordon
Philip. There are 1,600 cards represent-
ing the persons the committee judged
would be in a position to contribute
substantial amounts, and these are to
be divided among the teams. This time
the arrangement is for the division of
down-town cards according to estimat-
ed donations, the remainder to be divid-
ed according to territories as to pre-
sented. The names of the teams of
members are to be in the secretary's
hands by Monday noon, when the cards
will all be ready. That afternoon the
first list of subscribers will be pub-
lished. On Wednesday night the teams
will meet for the final planning, and on
Thursday morning the canvass will
commence.

One-Day Canvass.
It is a one-day canvass, and every
prospective contributor is requested to
be ready; those who find it impossible
to be in the city are to be requested to
leave checks for the canvassers. While
the wage-earners are not to be called
on, the chairman having suggested
that owing to the strenuous burdens of
the day they be not personally solicited.
It was made clear by Sir George yes-
terday that any who can contribute,
no matter what the amount may be,
will find their subscriptions deeply ap-
preciated. It is hoped, indeed, that
many will find it possible to mail con-
tributions to the honorary treasurer,
A. D. McLean, of the Bank of Com-
merce.

At the conclusion of the committee
meeting Sir George invited the members
and all those who are to work on the
teams to be his guests at a dinner at
the close of the canvass on Thursday
evening. Thursday noon there is to be
a recess in the canvass, when the
team-workers will lunch together and
compare notes of the day's progress.

OPENING MEETING OF LITERARY SOCIETY AT WESTERN UNIVERSITY

Fine Program Followed by an Enjoyable Dance.

A large crowd enjoyed the fine pro-
gram given last night at the opening
meeting of the Western University Lit-
erary Society, in the University "Gym"
on Oxford street.

The first part of the program was
strictly literary, and following an ad-
dress by the president, G. A. P. Brick-
enden, an address was given by John
Cottam and recitations by Robert Han-
nah. At 10 o'clock the musical part of
the program was begun, when a deli-
cious informal dance was put on.
Speaking on "The Searchlight of the
War," Mr. Cottam dealt with condi-
tions in the different countries, refer-
ring especially to the self-sacrifice of
Belgium, the great assistance the col-
onies had been to the Empire, the won-
der-works Italy had performed, and
finally, to the response of the United
States to the call.

"We will forgive Uncle Sam his
dilatoriness when we need help so
sorely," he added.

The great light was one of principle,
he stated, and the greatest concern was
the playing of the searchlight on those
staying at home. The question was
whether we were going to stand as we
would like to stand before the search-
light.

He expressed himself as strongly in
favor of universal military service, and
consequently of the military service
style.

"When I compare the men at the
front with the men who are at home,
it makes my blood boil," Mr. Cottam
declared. "We can blame the Germans
as we wish for the war, but we ought
to have been prepared ourselves."

In conclusion, he expressed it as his
belief that democracy was going to be
the great thing in the future.
Mr. Hannah delighted his audience
with "The Cremation of Sam McGee,"
from Robert W. Service, and "The
Army Transport Mule." At the con-
clusion of the literary part of the pro-
gram hearty votes of thanks were ex-
tended to Messrs. Hannah and Cottam.
During the enjoyable program of
dances which followed, Gus Edwards
presided at the piano in his usual
style.
