Virgo, according to Flamstead, includes no less than 110 stars. This constellation is very distinguishable, owing to the extraordinary number of *nebulæ* comprised within its limits. What is somewhat remarkable, is that it contains but one star of the first magnitude—not one of the second—ten of the third, and an equal number of the fourth magnitude. The determination of the orbit of *g* Virginis has engaged much of the attention of the Astronomers of modern times.
