SIGNS OF ABUNDANCE OF MONEY

(Maritime Merchant)
The conspicuous feature in the financial world just now is the rapidly increasing rate of money. In our last issue we referred to the reduction of the Bank of England rate to 3-1/2 p. c., which not long ago had been up as high as 5 p. c. It came about as a surprise last week that the rate should go still lower, to 3 p. c., and there was some expectation that it might go even lower, though up to the time of this writing this has not materialized. Not only are there signs of abundant money at the present time, but financiers apparently expect that the supply will increase. We were talking with a bank director the other day who predicted that we would soon see a plethora of money. And his prediction it seems is likely to be fulfilled quickly enough. We noticed the other day that Chicago banks, instead of waiting for the definite dates on which the special crop moving funds were to be returned to the treasury department at Washington, are voluntarily returning them in advance. Evidently they have more money than there is a demand for and the incident is naturally regarded as a significant indication of the outlook in the money market.
