LOCAL NEWS

A. E. Hudson, of the Dominion Railway Commission, who came here last night, will leave today for Bonny River to make a report on the fencing of the Shore Line there.

The figures for the exports from St. John during the last winter show a decrease of \$5,079,080. The total exports this year were \$24,277,850 as against \$29,356,930 for last year.

The government steamer Lansdowne was disabled yesterday off Black Point buoy, which she was preparing to take in tow. A line caught in the propeller of the vessel and she had to hoist distress signals as Captain Burns was unable to extricate her. The tug Lord Kitchener brought her into port.

SAYS TORONTO JAIL IS WORST ON CONTINENT

Toronto, May 7.—Dr. Bruce Smith, provincial inspector of prisons, has condemned the Toronto jail as overcrowded, ill ventilated, insanitary, a firetrap and the worst jail on the continent of America. He has recommended to the provincial secretary that the provincial grant be cut off immediately.

If this has not the desired effect the inspector says that the city of Toronto should be indicted for maintaining a nuisance. He declares that the discipline is lax and that immorality exists on account of that.

A CITY SURVEY THE BASIS FOR A CITY PLAN.

The basis for a city plan must be a city survey covering information as to four classes of fact:

- 1.—The facts of the physical environment of the people of the city.
- 2.—The social, facts concerning the people themselves and the reaction between them and their physical environment.
- 3.—The economic and financial facts as to the resources of the community
- 4.—The facts as to the legal and administrative conditions which must be reckoned with in any attempt to control the physical environment.—Frederick Law Olmsted.
