CRITICIZES GOVERNMENT

Leicestershire M. P. on British Trade Matters—The Ship-building Programme

London, Mar. 9.—In the debate which followed a statement by Andrew Bonar Law, chancellor of the exchequer in the House of Commons, during which he outlined the military situation, Percy Alfred Harris, member from Leicestershire, accused the government of placing such hindrances and restrictions on trading as to threaten after the war to deprive England of her supremacy as the world's greatest exporter. He complained that Leicestershire's staple industries were being diverted to Japan. He suspected, he said, that Japan was using her tonnage to capture trade and attack British markets instead of helping the allies.

Thomas James McNamara, financial secretary of the admiralty replied to criticisms which were voiced during a discussion on shipbuilding. He admitted the urgency of the problem and the necessity for more men to construct ships. The more parliament ventilates this subject, he said, the better the admiralty would be pleased.

He admitted that to realize forecasts "we must turn out double the tonnage in March that we produced in February." Asked if it could be done, he replied: "We must do our best."
