Tom Driscoll, sworn, stated that he resides at 154 Seymour Street, west, in the City of Kamloops, Count of Yale Province of British Columbia. That he did not see the accused on date in question. That the accused was not down to his place at all that day.

7. The Defence and Prosecution summed up the circumstances of the case, and the Magistrate, after deliberation found the accused GUILTY and fined her \$100.00 or i/d 3 months in gaol.

8. As the accused was unable to pay her fine, she is being escorted to Oakalla Prison Farm this date by Mrs. R.Dims, Matron, to serve her sentence.
