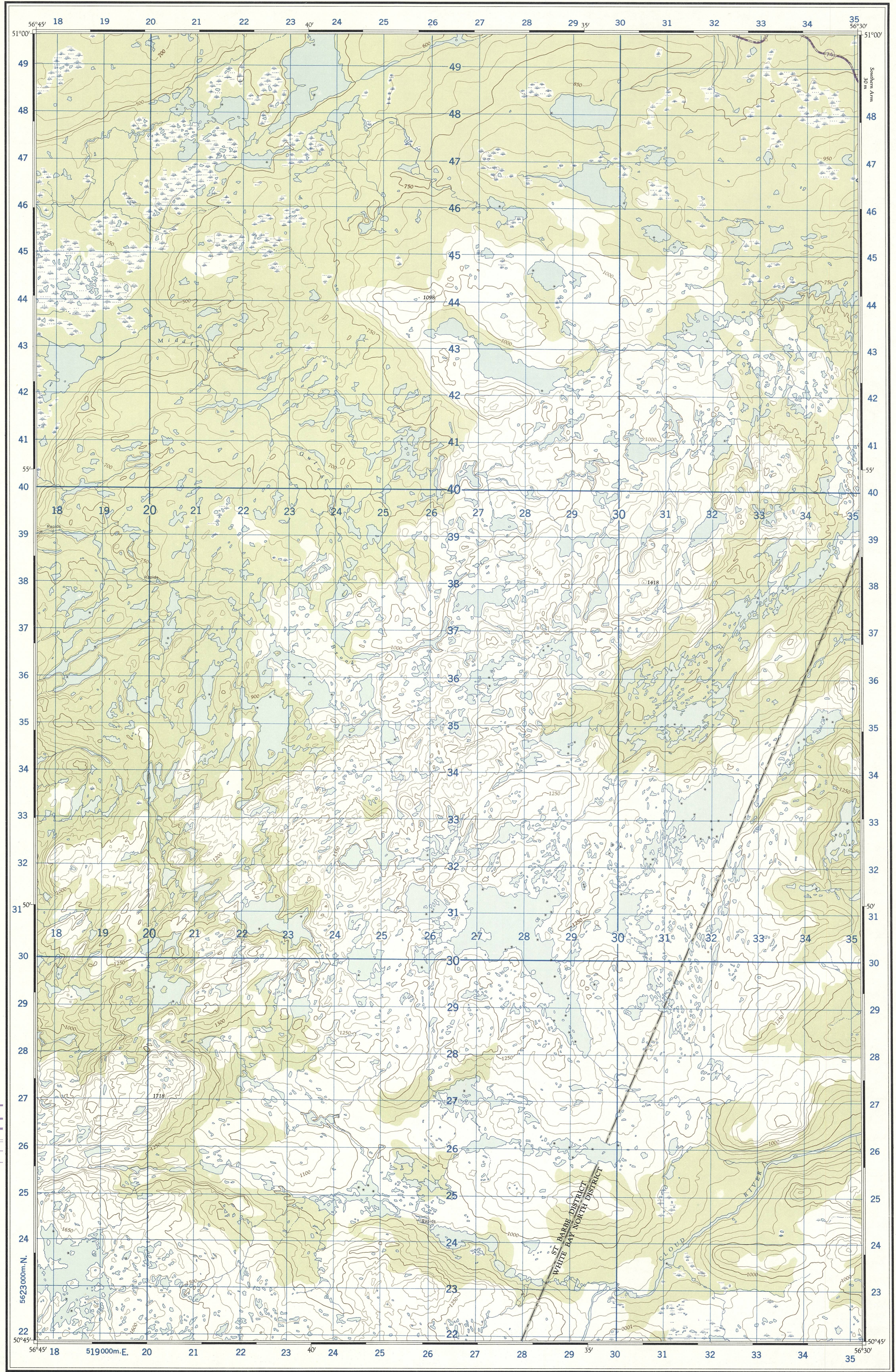




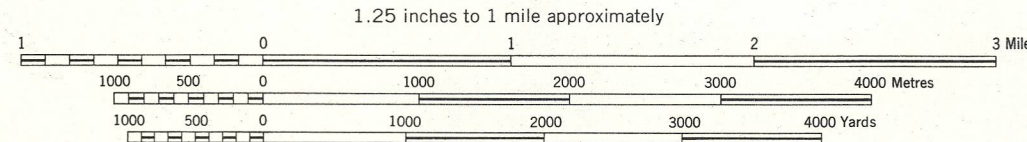

CASTORS RIVER NEWFOUNDLAND

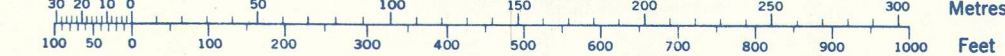
