

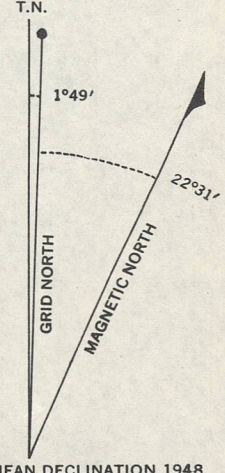

ANNUALLY

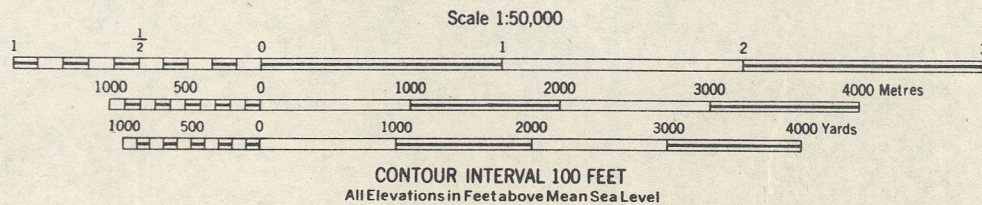
