

Mr. Tom Price, Premier of South Australia, now on a visit to England, was once a navy and was employed as a laborer on the building of the parliament house at Adelaide, where he is now supreme. He was born in Denbighshire in 1852 but grew up in Liverpool. Education he obtained at a penny school and at a night school connected with the Presbyterian church in Shaw street, Liverpool.
