An Extract out of the Register-Book of the Mediator, his Majesty the King of Sweden's Publick Minister.

At the Hague, February 10. 1697.

THIS Day, at Eleven in the Morning, Morning real fieur Caillieres, his most Christian Majesty's Minister came in Company with Monsieur Dyckwelt, to the House of the Swedish Minister the Mediator, and having produced and shewed to the said Mediator his tull Power, and that of his Imperial Majesty's Minister being also read, and Copies of both (after being compar'd with the Originals) exchang'd; He, the said Monsieus Cailleires, made the following Declaration.

Preliminary Articles.

I. THE King of France doth consent and agree,
That the Treaties of Westphalia and Nimegues
shall be the Basis and Foundation of the Negotiations for a General Peace with all the Consederates.

II. To restore Strasbourg in the same Condition

it was in when taken by his Majesty.

III. To restore to the King of Spain, Luxur

burgh in the Condition it is now in.

IV. Also the Cities of Mons and Charleroy, in the same Condition they are in at present.
