## BILL.

## An Act to facilitate the disuniting of the Counties of Lincoln and Welland, and for other purposes therein mentioned.

HEREAS the Municipal Council of the United Counties of Lincoln Preamble. and Welland, have by their Petition prayed that an Act may be passed to facilitate the disuniting of the County of Welland from the County of Lincoln for judicial and other purposes : And whereas it appears 5 by certificate of the Warden and Clerk of the said Municipal Council that an agreement has been entered into between the Provisional Municipal Council of the said County of Welland and the said Municipal Council of the said United Counties, for the adjustment and settlement of all debts of said United Counties, in the manner provided by the fifteenth section of 10 the Act of the Parliament of this Province passed in the twelfth year of Her Majesty's Reign, and intituled "An Act for abolishing the Territorial Divisions of Upper Canada into Districts, and for providing for temporary Unions of Counties for Judicial and other purposes, and for the future dissolution of such Unions, as the increase of wealth and population 15 may require," and that the several other provisions of the said Section have been complied with by the said County of Welland: And whereas it is necessary and expedient to carry into effect the prayer of the said Petition; Therefore Her Majesty, &c., enacts as follows:

I.
