An Act to amend chapter fifteen of the Consolidated Statutes for Lower Canada relating to Common Schools.

WHEREAS it is expedient to declare more explicitly the intention of Preamble. the Legislature in regard to the appropriation for Common Schools in the city of Montreal: Therefore Her Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Assembly 5 of Canada enacts as follows:

1. Notwithstanding any practice or interpretation heretofore prevail-What suming in regard to section 131 of cap. 15 of the Consolidated Statutes for shall be payLower Canada, the sum which the City Treasurer of the city of mon Schools
Montreal, shall be bound in pursuance of the said section to pay to out of City
the Boards of School Commissioners of the said city, shall be equal funds to the full amount to which the city would be entitled out of the

2.
