4. And the word "Subscription" in this Act, includes payment of Subscription the amount subscribed, as well as the mere act of subscription.

39. If there be any property, real or personal, in the hands of any Arbitration one Society organized under this Act, which belonged wholly or in part of property in to any other Society organized under former Acts or under this Act contains 5 to any other Society organized under former Acts, or under this Act, certain cases, and comprising the territory, or part thereof; out of which the Society, not enjoying possession of the property, was formed, then, and in that case, the said property, or the value thereof, may be equitably divided by arbitrations to be arranged between the parties; and if the Society 10 so holding such property refuses or neglects to arbitrate or divide the same or the value thereof, or to comply with any award made upon any such arbitration, the Society aggrieved may sue at law and recover its proportion of the same, or the amount to which it is entitled by any such award in any Court of Civil Jurisdiction, and the Minister of 15 Agriculture may order the grant of public money payable to the defaulting Society to be withheld while the default continues.

40. The Municipalities of any Citics, Towns, Villages, Counties, or Municipali-Townships may grant money or land in aid of the Board of Agriculture, make grants. the District Council, or the Agricultural Society duly organized within 20 the limits of the Municipality, for the purposes of this Act.

41. Throughout this Act the word "Agriculture" includes not only Interpretation the exploitation of cultivated lands, but also the improvement of wild land.

BOARDS OF ARTS AND MANUFACTURES.

42. The Board of Arts and Manufactures shall be composed of the Composition Minister of Agriculture, the Superintendent of Education, and twelve of Board. members elected by the institutes in incorporated towns.

43. Each institute, at its first meeting, in the month of January in Members from each year, shall elect and accredit to the Board of Arts and Manufac-30 tures one representative for every number of not less than one hundred members paying an annual subscription of one dollar, which shall be upon their roll.

44. A statement, verified upon oath, of the names contained in the Institutes roll of each institute for the ensuing year, shall be transmitted to the be formed into 35 Minister of Agriculture, before the month of January in each year. It Golleges. shall be the duty of the Minister of Agriculture to divide the institutes into Electoral Colleges, taking as the basis of such division the total number of members of all the institutes in Lower Canada, divided by twelve; if it should appear, after the institutes have been notified of 40 such division, that too great a number of members have been elected, the Minister of Agriculture may decide which members shall retire.

45. The regular meetings of the Board of Arts and Manufactures Meetings. shall be held pursuant to adjournment, or be called by the Secretary, at the instance of the President or Vice-President, cr upon the written 45 request of any five members; and at least five days notice of such meetings shall be given to each member.

46. The members of the Board shall elect from among themselves a Appointment President and Vice-President; or in their absence, a Chairman pro of Presidents tempore; seven members of the Board shall be a quorum.
