**Concern In Snuffing Out Sniffing**

Parents, police and the authorities are not the only ones concerned with the current incidence of glue sniffing.

The Addiction Research Foundation reports that three of the major manufacturers of airplane glue are currently working on the problem.

It is reported that one manufacturer is working on a fumeless substitute; another is seeking an additive which will cause sniffers to sneeze, cry or vomit; the largest and oldest of the three is engaged in a preventive educational program in co-operation with the addiction Research Foundation and the department of health.

This program is aimed at helping teachers, parents and retailers curb the dangerous craze.

Bruce Beer, MP for Peel, told The News last week that he is prepared to take the problem to the legislature.

Currently, there are no laws on the books dealing with glue sniffing.

Marijuana smokers may be taken into court

and prosecuted under the Narcotics Act; alcohol users may be prosecuted under the Liquor Act; but there is nothing on the books making glue sniffing a punishable offense.

H. D. Archibald, director of ARF, says they have assumed the attitude that no one angle of attack on the problem is likely to be the answer.

"The trouble with legislation of this kind," he

said, "is that it will immediately criminalize a lot of kids who experiment with everything from glue to nail polish and paint thinners."

**ANSWER?**

"Perhaps the answer may lie in health legislation rather than criminological."

"It may well be that providing proper facilities and regulations for treatment is the answer,"

he said.

"Further research into the problem is also necessary," said Mr. Archibald. "It would be interesting to learn, for example, the psychological factors that predispose a youngster to this sort of thing."

"Without a doubt," he concluded, "further education of both parents and children is necessary."
