Price deserves more

Jess Roden. The Player Not the Game. Island Records.

Jess Roden has come up with an album that, while every bit as good as his other three, is commercially far more interesting and viable.

Roden has left his English roots and band behind and opted for the New York expertise of

Joel Dorn, producer, and Leon Pendervis, arranger. The results spotlight Roden's exquisite voice and the songs, like The Hardest Blow, written by Roden, have all the earmarks of solid maturity.

The real highlights are the Doris Tauber-Johnny Mercer gem, Drinking Again, and Doc Pomus's classic Lonely Avenue. Roden goes from saloon-singer to rock tempo in an easy transition that shows off his versatility.

Roden is a very smooth artist, and Dorn's work shows efficiency and class. Given the usual variables of the record business, and with the right breaks, The Player Not the Game could be the album to do it for Roden. I hope so. I think he has a tremendous amount of talent.

Alan Price. United Artists. JT-LA809-G. In some cases, the high quality of an artist's work

never matches the recognition he receives for it. Alan Price is a case in point.

Long one of the premier songwriters of popular music, his sophisticated style, even in his early work with the Animals, never won the wide-spread praise that writers of lesser ability got.

His solo albums, many of them unavailable in this country — for instance, the excellent Shout Across the Street and Performing Price — illustrate a rare talent.

Price is an accomplished musician, expressive vocalist and a fine songwriter. So why the hell does he remain one of the great unknowns in popular music. I throw my hands up in bewilderment.

Poor management? Lacklustre record companies? Who knows. Perhaps it's because Price's understated music is a little to the left of pop's mainstream. He has carefully evaded the Tex-Mex formula that — tried and true as they may be — lack any real substance. Price, being a songwriter of substance, has been aiming a bit too high for the average pop palate.

This album is well done and made by a man who doesn't understand the meaning of the word compromise. Of particular interest are I've Been Hurt, I Wanna Dance and the wonderful Poor Boy, which conjures up fond memories of Price's earlier work on Oh Lucky Man.

'Tis the season to carry out all those New Year's resolutions.

For instance, checking out books, films and cassette tapes on diet and nutrition from the Mississauga Library System can help you establish better eating habits for the new year — if your resolutions are in that direction.

One of the handiest nutrition guides is Nutrient Value of Some Common Foods, a large-

sized pamphlet produced by the Canada Department of National Health and Welfare. Over 520 foods, including cooked meats, milk products, imitation cream products, fruit drinks and mixes are analyzed according to weight, moisture content, calories, protein and individual vitamins.

Dr. Zak Sabry, biochemist and nutritionist, and Ruth Fremes, home economist and radio and television broadcaster, are co-authors of Nutriscore, which offers advice on how to rate yourself to perfect health using an innovative Nutriscore chart. Nutriscore also covers fad diets, nutritional needs, nutrition sense, many charts on the nutrition contents of foods and recommended daily dietary allowances.

Harding Le Riche's Complete Family Book of Nutrition and Meal Planning contains a blend of basic information on foods, nutrition and diet, as well as information on controversial additives.

L. J. Bogert's Nutrition and Physical Fitness is a well-known text covering all aspects of nutrition. The field is divided into three sections: nutrients and their functions; food

intake and utilization and applied nutrition, which includes information on food habits and beliefs; and diets and disorders related to over- and under-weight conditions.

Among the many books on child nutrition is Nutrition for the Growing Years by Margaret McWilliams. Nutrition theory is blended with the practical realities of feeding infants and children. V. Lansky's Feed Me, I'm Yours offers interesting ideas and recipes which can be used as a supplement to the McWilliams book. Books

for children include Hoban's Bread and Jam for Frances, Dandelion by Rose Stola, The Natural Snack Cookbook by Jill Pinkwater and One Pinch of Sunshine.

Films, such as Eat, Drink and Be Wary, Menu, Fad Diet Circus, Weight Control, A Chemical Feast and Diet for a Small Planet supply information on many different aspects of nutrition and menu planning.

NOTICE OF APPLICATION FOR APPROVAL TO EXPROPRIATE LAND (FORM 2)

IN THE MATTER OF an application by THE REGIONAL MUNICIPALITY OF PEEL (formerly The Corporation of the County of Peel) for approval to expropriate land being part of Lots 5 and 6, Concession 1 West of Hurontario Street, in the City of Mississauga, in The Regional Municipality of Peel (formerly in the Township of Toronto, in the County of Peel),

for the purpose of widening Britannia Road.

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that application has been made for approval to expropriate the land described as follows:

ALL AND SINGULAR those certain parcels or tracts of land and premises situate, lying and being in the City of Mississauga, in The Regional Municipality of Peel (formerly in the Township of Toronto, in the County of Peel) and Province of Ontario, and being composed of those parts of Lots Five and Six in the First Concession West of Hurontario Street in the said City more particularly designated as Parts Numbers 1 2 3 5 6 8 and 10 according to a reference plan deposited in the Registry Office for the Registry Division of Peel (No. 43) as Number 43R-2742

Notes:

- The Expropriations Act, Revised Statutes of Ontario, 1970, provides that:
 - where an inquiry is requested, it shall be conducted by an inquiry officer appointed by the Minister of Justice and Attorney General;
 - the inquiry officer;
 - shall give every party to the inquiry an opportunity to present evidence and argument and to examine and cross-examine witnesses, either personally or by his counsel or agent; and
 - may recommend to the approving authority that a party to the inquiry be paid a fixed amount for his costs of the inquiry not to exceed \$200 and the approving authority may in its discretion order the expropriating authority to pay such costs forthwith.
- "owner" and "registered owner" as defined in the Act as follows: "owner" includes a mortgagee, tenant, execution creditor, a person entitled to a limited estate or interest in land, a committee of the estate of a mentally incompetent person or of a person incapable of managing his affairs, and a guardian, executor, administrator or trustee in whom land is vested; "registered owner" means an owner of land whose interest in the land is defined and whose name is specified in an instrument in the proper registry, land titles or sheriff's office, and includes a person shown as a tenant of land on the last revised assessment roll.
- The expropriating authority, each owner who notifies the approving authority that he desires a hearing in respect of the lands intended to be expropriated and any owner added as a party by the inquiry officer, are parties to the inquiry.
