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Village to Bull Horns it is no less a distance than 25 miles with Farms between each place and as we divide our force up between the Lower, Middle, and Upper Villages it requires at least two men devoting the whole of their time to do justice to the work. This spring, I have been constantly on the move from one field to another and saw that it required another man. -

Naturally I shall continue so far as I am able to supervise the whole work, but should I have to fill the dual position of Agent and Instructor some of the work will of necessity be neglected; to say nothing about the Piegiams, which have not been visited by me, as often as might be desirable -

As regards the last clause in your letter I would call your attention to my letter H^c 579 of the 15th inst in which I enclose Estimates for Wagon shed, harness room, Implement room, and Coal house, also Drug Store we can manage the Cow shed and Milk house ourselves. -

My reason for not moving out sooner than the 1st June are that the water is too high for fording at present though lowering and that it will be more convenient to check and forward the current months
