INTRODUCTION

This is part 4 of finding aid 434, consisting of a computer index arranged by consective volume number. This finding aid is also available in hard copy at the Public Archives and at the University of New Brunswick, Fredericton.

Researchers are reminded that there are other finding aids to the Bennett Papers. Parts I and 2 (available on microfilm reel C-4495) consist of file lists to the Political, Personal, Invitations and Clippings Series. Part 3 is a detailed computer index arranged alphabetically by keyword (available on reels C-10855 to C-10858). The Public Archives makes the microfilm copy of finding aid 434 available on interlibrary loan.

The Public Archives has only a microfilm copy of the Bennett Papers. The originals are held by the University of New Brunswick. Persons wishing to borrow portions of the papers on interlibrary loan should take note of the UNB reel number. This is essential since the University, not the Public Archives, makes the microfilm copy of the Bennett Papers available on interlibrary loan.

This finding aid, the volume sort, will be of particular assistance to researchers using material in consecutive volumes, since it is in effect on extremely detailed file list, showing the significant contents as well as the titles of each file.

Pages missing on the microfilm copy of the papers may mean several things, such as the presence of duplicates or an error in numbering. Also, most periodicals and other published items available in large libraries have not been filmed.
