Epileptic  
now Lunatic

The Supt. said, he is here according to promise, to hear what they may have to report, he has, first; to announce, that on Thursday next, he will resume <sup>the</sup> payment, when, he hopes all the unpaid will come forward, and close <sup>the</sup> list.

2. They will recollect, having authorised the placing of Isaac Lewis, an epileptic, in the Hospital at Hamilton, now, he regrets to inform them, that the House Surgeon, writes, Lewis having become <sup>with violence</sup> a mania ~~and violent~~, it is necessary, he should be removed to a Lunatic Asylum.

He (the Supt.) has written the Department for authority, to take such steps as may be requisite.
