Dear Sir, -

It is desired to make a special effort to recruit additional pupils for the Brandon and Elkhorn industrial schools. The Department is aware that there are a number of children, probably 30, on the Fisher River and Peguis Indian reserves who would be better placed in residential schools, and I have to ask you to be good enough to take immediate steps to have these children collected and sent to Brandon and Elkhorn.

Indians and they should realize that they can provide for a certain number of their children comfortably by sending them to these schools. You may make arrangements for transportation for them and have a responsible person accompany both contingents; this will be at the expense of the Department. I hope you will be able to arrange this
